



The Benefits of Earning a College Degree

- Higher Earning Potential
 - More Job Opportunities
 - Greater Benefits
 - Job Satisfaction
 - Job Stability

UC Admission Requirements

- A-G courses with a “C” grade or better
 - SAT or ACT Plus writing
 - Highest score in one sitting-report all
 - SAT Subject Tests recommended by certain campuses and majors
 - Comprehensive review
 - Meet all deadlines
- 

Key Messages – Bottom Line

- Complete UC's admissions subject requirements ("a-g") – at least 11 by the end of the junior year – and do as well as you can in them
- Better preparation = more choices
- Campuses will look beyond grades and test scores
- Performance relative to others in your school is important
- Apply broadly
- Application Fee: \$70 per campus
- Application due: November 30th

CSU Admissions Requirements

- A-G courses with a “C” grade or better
- SAT or ACT (without writing)
 - highest score in each section/super score
- Eligibility Index
 - GPA above 3.0 automatically qualifies admission
 - Higher index increases admission at impacted schools/programs.

Key Messages – Bottom Line

- Complete admissions subject requirements (“a-g”) – do as well as you can in them
- Local Admission Area – CSU Fullerton
- Impaction – Major/Campus
- Apply broadly
- Application Fee: \$70 per campus
- Application window is November 1st – 30th
(Can begin the process Oct.1st)


Private Colleges & Universities

- Admission criteria similar to CSU/UC (required classes, test scores)
- Typically smaller class sizes
- Application requirements and dates vary by school. Many will participate in the Common Application System
- Rolling admissions – the earlier you apply the more \$ you qualify for

Common Application

- Send request to your counselor

- Must meet with your counselor after you send the request!!!! We need more info from you.

Community College

- Financially affordable
 - Bachelor's Degree does not indicate community college
 - If unsure of a major, can explore courses at a cheaper cost
 - Guaranteed transfer to a UC/CSU after completing 60 units of general ed. and lower division major
 - Admission is easier than many college/universities
 - General Education classes are “the same” everywhere

Deadlines!!!!

- UC application available August 1st.
 - **Application due - November 30th!**
- Common app available August 1st.
 - **Deadlines vary by school and application type**
- October 1st - CSU application available online.
 - **Application due - November 30th!**

● DO NOT wait for the last minute!

App. Fees: UC \$70 per campus

Common app. \$ varies by school

More Deadlines!!

- **SAT/ACT due dates** - December is the last day for UC/CSU. (Private Colleges have different deadlines)
- October is the deadline for all impacted CSU campuses.
- If you apply to private schools please request your **letters of recommendation** from your counselor ASAP- PLEASE give us at least two weeks notice!
- Check **scholarship** deadlines on a regular basis.

TRANSCRIPTS

- **UC/CSU – due July 1, 2020**
 - Send only **ONE** final transcript!
- **Private schools**
 - If you are using the Common App, counselors will submit your current transcript as they complete your letter of recommendation and your mid-year transcript report in February. **YOU** must submit your final transcript in July, 2020.
- Can **ONLY** be sent electronically through
 - **www.parchment.com**

Paying for College

- Financial Aid Package
 - Grants and Scholarships
 - Loans
 - Parent
 - Student
 - Work Study
- Variable factors determine package
 - EFC - FAFSA
 - Institution

Financial Aid

- www.fafsa.ed.gov
- You may submit the **FAFSA** beginning October 1, 2019. Earlier submission can lead to greater financial aid awards. Due date is March 2, 2020
- **Cal Grant** GPA verification are completed electronically by VPHS.

NCAA Information

- Must meet minimum GPA and SAT/ACT requirements to participate in Div. 1 or 2
 - Complete required classes
- Must register with NCAA Clearinghouse no later than 12th grade.
- Submit application and transcripts for verification
