

VPHS CLASS OF 2019 GRAD NIGHT RULES

RULES & REGULATIONS

In addition to the Venue's policies in place, the following rules and regulations apply during GRAD NIGHT:

- Absolutely NO alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind are permitted.
- Only buses or chaperon driven vehicles will be permitted to park. Absolutely NO student driven vehicles will be permitted.
- No student will be permitted to leave GRAD NIGHT prior to the venue closing.
- All prescription medication must be carried by a chaperone at all times unless a special exception had been approved prior to the event. Asthma inhalers are an exception to this rule and may be carried by students.
- All students and guests MUST adhere the Dress Code provided or entrance to GRAD NIGHT may not be permitted.
- No outside food, drink, coolers or other food containers are permitted.
- If actions at anytime during GRAD NIGHT become unacceptable and/or a hindrance to others, GRAD NIGHT personnel and/or venue management have the right to evict me and call my parents/guardian to remove me from the venue.

DRESS CODE

Acceptable examples:

- GRAD NIGHT T-shirts (NO other shirts allowed)
- Jeans
- Comfortable, closed toe shoes
- Khakis or dress pants
- Capris or leggings
- Shorts
- Jackets/sweatshirts/sweaters
- Purses NO larger than 8 by 10 inches

The following items are NOT PERMITTED:

- NO T-shirt other than GRAD NIGHT T-shirt
- NO Backpacks or duffle bags
- NO Clothing in poor condition (i.e. torn jeans and shirts, etc.)
- NO Extremely revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suit tops or bottoms, tops showing midriff, see through clothing, etc.)
- NO briefcases, hip packs, camera bags, or tote bags
- No clothing or belts with spikes, studs, chains, etc.

Cell phone are permitted
