The completed course request forms MUST be turned in to your counselor at your one-on-one counselor meeting **February 9 – 13, 2026**. To choose your courses, review your transcript and the Course Catalog course description at [www.orangeusd.org](http://www.orangeusd.org). Students who do not choose courses during the specified time will have their courses selected by their counselor. **Per Ed Code 46145, Seniors MUST have a minimum of 5 classes both semesters.** Online and Bridge classes are NOT considered campus classes. Space is limited for ALL online classes. Classes with math requirements have the requirement noted in parentheses.

Every effort will be made to give students the courses they have selected unless the courses are unavailable or prerequisites have not been met. If a student would like to change his/her course selection, he must come to summer orientation in August. These changes will be allowed ONLY if there is room in the new course requested.

**\* AP/HONORS Request: Students and parents need to understand the Honors and AP courses are rigorous and may meet certain college requirements. As a condition of enrollment the student is required to remain in the class for the entire year.**
